

City of Minburn Ordinance 105.05
OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED

No person shall allow, cause, or permit open burning of combustible materials where the products of combustion are emitted into the open air without passing through a chimney or stack, except that open burning is permitted in the following circumstance: (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[455B] and 567-100.2)

1. Disaster Rubbish. The open burning of rubbish, including landscape waste, for the duration of the community disaster period in cases where an officially declared emergency condition exists. (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[3a])
2. Trees and Tree Trimmings. The open burning of trees and tree trimmings at a City-operated burning site, provided such burning is conducted in compliance with the rules established by the State Department of Natural Resources (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[3b])
3. Flare Stacks. The open burning or flaring of waste gases, provided such open burning or flaring is conducted in compliance with the rules established by the State Department of Natural Resources (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[3c])
4. Recreational Fires. Open fires for cooking, heating, recreation, and ceremonies, provided they comply with the limits for emission of visible air contaminants established by the State Department of Natural Resources. (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[3e])
5. Training Fires. Fires set for the purpose of bona fide training of public or industrial employees in fire fighting methods, provided that training fires are conducted in compliance with the rules established by the State Department of Natural Resources (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[3g])
6. Variance. Any person wishing to conduct open burning of materials not permitted herein may make application for a variance to the director. (Code of Iowa, 567-23.2[2])
